

Renaissance Accelerated Math® Goal-Setting Chart

When you and your students become comfortable using Accelerated Math, begin working toward these recommended guidelines:

- Students average 75% or better on practices and exercises
- Students average 85% or better on regular tests

Use the following tools to help your students set, track, and achieve their goals.

Resource Document	Purpose
Student Math Plan	Fill out this plan with each student to set marking period goals. Students use the document to track their own progress.
Software Tools	Purpose
Set Student Goals in Software	The software tracks student progress for default or customized objectives mastered and test percent correct goals. To set goals in the software, click Teams & Goals on the Accelerated Math home page
Create Teams in Software	Assign students to teams and view each team's progress on team reports (see below).
Reports	Purpose
Diagnostic Report	Track detailed progress of each pupil for objectives mastered and average percentage correct.
Goal History Report	View pupil progress toward mastery targets for the current marking period.
Team Status Report	View team progress toward mastery targets for the current marking period.
Team Standings Chart	Print this chart weekly to display how teams compare to one another as they progress toward mastery targets.
